In 2023, two initiatives intriguingly came into existence simultaneously:

1. Global Summit on Responsible Artificial Intelligence in the Military Domain (REAIM)

2. Political Declaration on Responsible Military Use of Artificial Intelligence and Autonomy



Political Declaration on Responsible Military Use of Artificial Intelligence and Autonomy (February 2023)

Initiator: USA

Endorsing States: 51 countries (As of January 2024)
